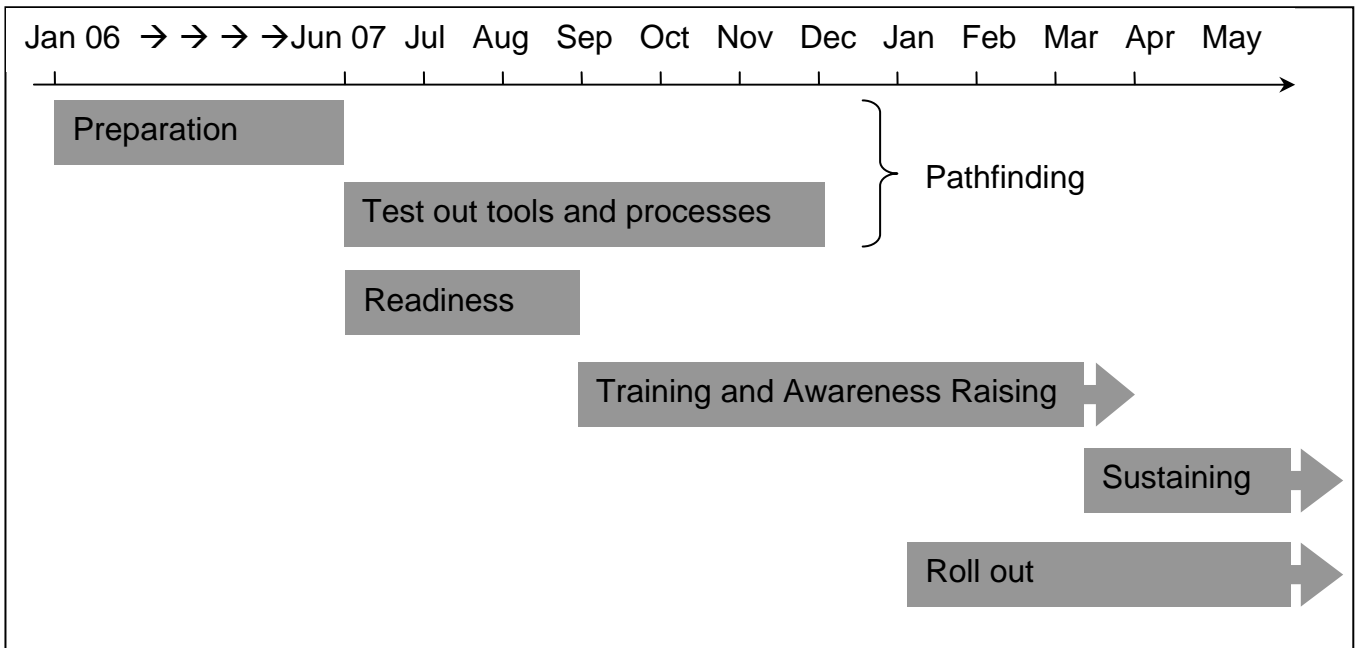


Proposed Pathfinding and roll out schedule

Below provides a high level view of the AXS roll out plan.



Pathfinding

The 9 pathfinder areas are now fully equipped with the necessary training to support the integrated working and use of supporting tools and processes. These are shown in Appendix (i).

Proposed roll out areas

The AXS Network consultation 20 February to 20 April 07 outlines the natural expansion from Pathfinders to neighbouring areas shown in Appendix (ii). Many non Learning community based practitioners and staff already have the skills to support the roll out into neighbouring areas.

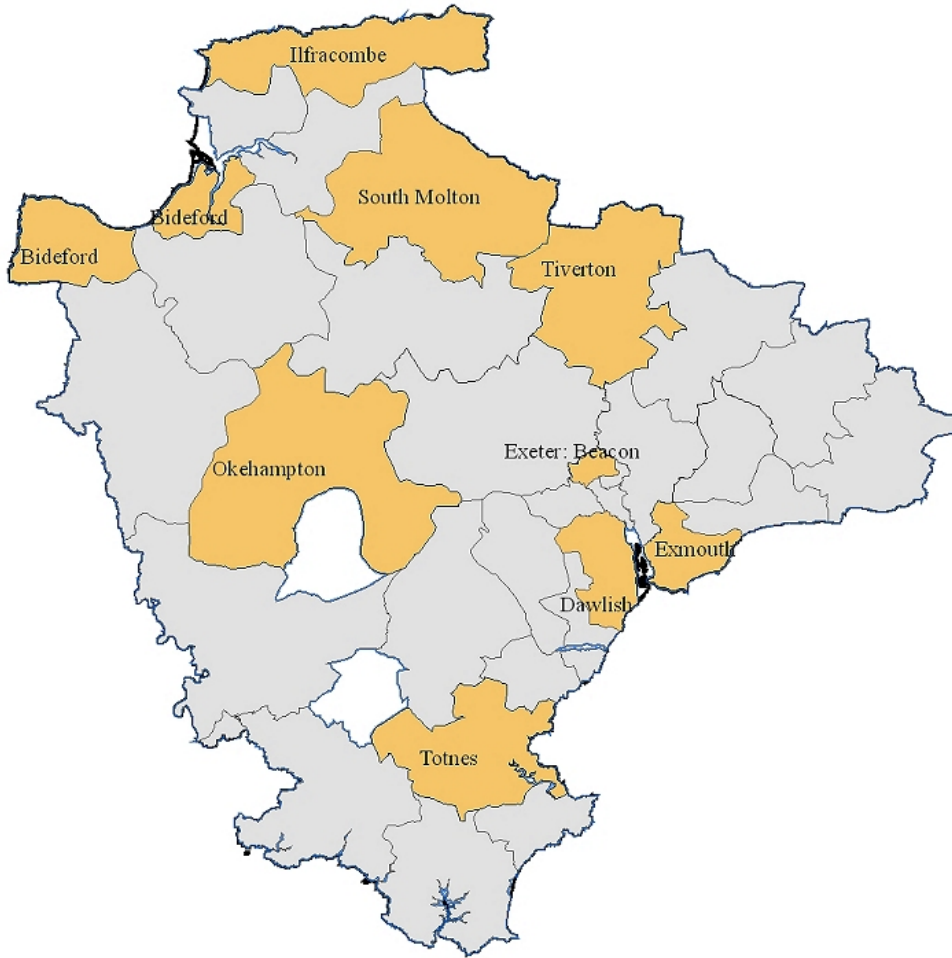
This is not suggesting that areas not attached to pathfinders cannot engage in the training activity but this will need careful consideration through the AXS Programme Board.

Roll out Pace

A detailed workforce analysis is underway to best inform the pace at which the roll out can be achieved. This will assess the training needs across the partnership workforce.
