Currently much of this is commissioned from non core budgets and ceases in 2010.

**Analysis of progress;**

**a) highlight key issues:**

Funding for some programmes to engage NEETs in learning comes to an end in 2010. Previously these have been funded through ESF or LSC "fighting funds. If NEETs are not to rise and foundations are to be laid for raising of the participation age to 18 it is essential that this provision is continued as the LA takes over responsibilities for funding from the LSC.
