Analysis of progress;

a) highlight key issues:

- Need to increase prevalence of breastfeeding - bid submitted to the Department of Health for additional funds to promote Breastfeeding Friendly Initiative in hospitals and the community.
- Quality physical education in secondary schools is slightly below target. Further progress required at KS4.
- Target missed for recording of height and weight in 2008, but it is likely that Devon achieved target in 2009
- Teenage pregnancy off target. Devon in lowest quartile nationally for improvement from baseline.
- Chlamydia screening target missed: implementation plan was developed but delayed start to programme limited uptake

b) highlight successes:

- At all ages immunisation uptake rates in Devon are above the England average.
- New national target introduced in 2008 for the recording of Breastfeeding at 6-8 weeks. Devon exceeded the national target of 85% by achieving a coverage rate of 90.9%. This is a particular achievement given the baseline of 50% in Sept 08.
- Healthy Schools and Healthy School Plus ahead of target
- Targets on physical activity achieved for Primary schools
- Devon young people have excellent access to drug treatment services. Devon Drug and Alcohol Action Team (DAAT) services are third ranked nationally

Identify service action in hand to improve outcomes; including issues that require action by CT

New Teenage Pregnancy Board established September 2008 chaired by director of children's services. National Support Team visited Devon in November 2008. New action plan developed and this is performance managed through the teenage pregnancy and young people's sexual health board. Teenage pregnancy included as part of the refreshed CYPP.
